Team Check In

- Coach will check in at designated check in area in HUB lobby with a **PRINTED SportsEngine Roster. (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

GENERAL

- **Team camps can be set up in designated areas at the HUB. Spots will be numbered, ONE numbered spot per team.** Be respectful to the teams around you.
- **Please DO NOT block emergency exits in the team camp areas.**
- Do NOT setup team areas in lobby/foyer those are for spectators and officials. **Do NOT take chairs and tables out of lobby area for team camps. Bring your OWN tables and chairs.**
- Outside food/drinks can be brought into the facility, but no plug-in devices are allowed i.e., crockpots, rice cookers etc.
- If spills happen, please notify the tournament desk so we can get them cleaned up ASAP.
- **ALL TEAM CAMP AREAS MUST BE CLEANED UP PRIOR TO LEAVING. GARBABGE CANS AND RECYCLING ARE PROVIDED FOR YOU. RESPECT THE FACILITY.**
- **NO peppering, ball handling in the team area or lobby. Teams must wait until they get on the court to start warm-ups with the balls.**

- Please make sure to find the tournament director before you leave so we can assure that reffing assignments are covered and your area is clean and that you haven't forgotten anything!
- Team Benches | WATER ONLY (no food/other drinks) IS ALLOWED ON THE PLAYING SURFACE— THIS INCLUDES THE SCORER'S TABLE!!
- No pets are allowed in the facility.
- Please supervise all children

PARKING

- DO NOT park on the north side directly next to the building that is a fire lane, and they will make you move.
- Do NOT Park in the HUB Employee Parking spaces.
- DO NOT Park in front of the dumpster
- Overflow parking is out in the outer fields.
- Do NOT park in adjacent business parking lots.

POWER LEAGUE FORMAT

Warm-ups are 5-5 for the first two rounds of pool play, and then 3-3 after that. Serving must be done within this time.

Official and Referee Information: R1's will be provided for all matches

R2's may be provided as available, if NOT please have an ADULT R2. Teams must provide R2's, line judges and scorekeeping crews.

If we ask your local team to fill a ref assignment for an out of town team to travel home, please be willing to assist.

Round 1 Pool Play

- 4 TEAM Pool play matches are the best 2/3 with no cap.
- The top 8 teams are seeded in the GOLD Pools. Teams 9-16 are seeded in the SILVER Pools
- **ALL START TIMES ARE APPROX. GAMES WILL BEGIN IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE PREVIOUSLY SCHEDULED MATCH.**

Round 2 Bracket Play

- **Teams who finish 1st & 2nd in their pool will move into a bracket matched up with teams from the opposite Gold or Silver Pool**
 - Gold Pools move to Gold Bracket 1
 - 4 teams
 - Finishes in this bracket will determine seeding for the GOLD Pools for the next Power League.
 - Silver Pools move to Silver Bracket 1
 - 4 teams
 - 1st and 2nd place team from this bracket will MOVE UP to the GOLD POOLS for NEXT Power League
 - 1st round losing teams from this bracket will remain in the Silver Pools for next power league.
- **Teams who finish 3rd & 4th will move into a bracket matched up with teams from the opposite Gold or Silver Pool**
 - Gold Pools move to Gold Bracket 2
 - 4 teams
 - 1st round losing teams from this bracket will MOVE DOWN to the SILVER POOLS for NEXT Power League.
 - 1st and 2nd place teams from this bracket will remain in the Gold Pools for next power league.
 - Silver Pools move to Silver Bracket 2
 - 4 teams
 - Finishes in this bracket assist in seeding for the Silver Pools for the next Power League.
